Waste Minimization

Electronics Disposal:

- 1. Installation of special bins for disposing of old electronics and batteries.
- 2.Regular campaigns to collect unwanted electronics for recycling.
- 3. Collaboration with e-waste recycling companies to ensure proper disposal.



Reducing Single-Use Plastic:

- 1.Use of reusable dishes, bottles, and food containers.
- 2.Ban on plastic cups, bottles, and bags.
- 3. Encouraging the use of reusable bags and ecofriendly packaging for products.



Separate Waste Collection:

- 1.Installation of containers for separate waste collection (plastic, paper, glass, organic waste).
- 2.All staff and students must be trained in proper waste sorting.
- 3.Regular educational seminars and workshops on waste recycling and proper disposal.



Energy Saving and Greening

One of the key goals of sustainable development is the rational use of energy and the creation of comfortable natural spaces in educational and work environments.

What steps are being taken?

- Transition to energy-efficient lighting (LED lamps) to reduce electricity consumption.
- Installation of motion sensors for automatic light shutdown in unoccupied rooms.
- Placement of indoor plants in offices and classrooms to improve air quality.

Additional initiatives:

- Mini-gardens and flower beds are being created on campus.
- Students are actively involved in campus greening projects.
- Competitions are held for the best green space design.


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Reducing Energy and Water Consumption
